Rutland Recycling

New Improved Service:

We are pleased to report that for collections from Monday 4th April 2011 we will collect far more items from your grey bin for recycling as follows:

Plastics

Yoghurt pots

Food trays and punnets (not black plastic)

Plastic film (not bubble wrap)

Margarine and Butter tubs

Probiotic drinks containers

Ice Cream tubs

Rigid plastic packaging

Drink Cartons

At the same time you can also start to recycle all types of drinks cartons (milk, juice etc) including Tetra Paks; just put them in your grey bin.

Food and drink residues should be removed or rinsed from all items to help keep your grey bin clean and fresh.



Household Batteries

Put small non rechargeable household batteries, up to AA & C sizes together with coin & button cells, into your grey bin. Other batteries can be taken to a Civic Amenity site for recycling.



Shredded Paper

Put unbagged shredded paper into your grey bin, under other items to stop it blowing out on windy days.

Civic Amenity Sites

In order to improve cost effectiveness we have reviewed use of civic amenity sites and will be adapting their opening times to reflect when the vast majority of residents visit. As from 4th April 2011 the following opening hours will apply:

Months	Cottesmore C A Site Mon to Sun	North Luffenham C A Site Fri to Mon (inclusive) only
April to September	10am to 6pm	10am to 6pm
October to March	11am to 5pm	11am to 5pm

Please note the North Luffenham site is closed Tuesdays to Thursdays.

We have increased recycling facilities at the C A sites so that items such as CDs, DVDs, plate glass, mirrors, carpets and mattresses will no longer go to landfill.
